## REGULATORY INSTRUCTION Nº 002/PPCJ/VRPPI/2018

The present Regulatory Instruction, within the scope of the *Stricto Sensu* Postgraduate Program in Juridical Science (PPCJ/UNIVALI), establishes guidelines regarding the Internationalization Plan and the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, and provides other provisions.

The Vice-Rector of Research, Postgraduate Studies and Innovation from the *Universidade do Vale do Itajaí* (UNIVALI) and the Coordinator of the *Stricto Sensu* Postgraduate Program in Juridical Science at the *Universidade do Vale do Itajaí* (PPCJ/UNIVALI), by virtue of their attributions and in accordance with the statutory provisions, considering:

The precepts of Resolution 092/CONSUN/2016, which approved the UNIVALI's Internationalization Policy;

The signing of the Double Degree Agreement for Master's and Doctorate degree between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, on October 11, 2017;

The deliberations from the PPCJ/UNIVALI Collegiate meetings, as well as the results of institutional planning and self-assessment evaluations;

The need for institutional oversight of joint international research conducted by faculty, students, and *alumni* from the Master's and Doctorate Programs of PPCJ/UNIVALI, ensuring their proper alignment with the respective Areas of Concentration, Research Lines, and Research Projects;

The relevance of consolidating the internationalization activities of PPCJ/UNIVALI, aiming for internationally impactful academic production stemming from institutionalized and sustained research projects, optimizing the mobility of faculty and students, and establishing international research networks with external funding, in line with UNIVALI's directives and the *Coordenação de Aperfeiçoamento do Pessoal de Nível Superior* (CAPES) determinations;

## **INSTRUCT**:

**Art. 1.** This Regulatory Instruction provides, within the scope of PPCJ/UNIVALI, in its Master's and Doctorate Programs, guidelines regarding the Internationalization Plan and the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the *Stricto Sensu* Postgraduate Program in Juridical Science at the *Universidade do Vale do Itajaí* (PPCJ/UNIVALI) and the Delaware Law School/Widener University.



## UNIVERSIDADE DO VALE DO ITAJAÍ

- **Art. 2.** This Regulatory Instruction defines the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University as the academic articulation aiming to drive the creation of high-impact scientific knowledge, university mobility, and the innovation and extension processes resulting from the exchange between institutions, by combining competencies from researchers and research groups, which may or may not involve the sharing of facilities.
- **Art. 3.** This Regulatory Instruction binds PPCJ/UNIVALI's faculty, students, and *alumni*, in its Master's and Doctorate Programs, to teaching, research, innovation, extension, and internationalization activities with the Delaware Law School/Widener University.
- **Art. 4.** It is the responsibility of the PPCJ/UNIVALI's Coordination to ensure proper functioning of the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, observing parameters of excellence, effectiveness, social and academic impact, and adherence to the respective Areas of Concentration, Research Lines, and Research Projects.
- **Art. 5.** To impulse the production of high-impact scientific knowledge, the PPCJ/UNIVALI will prioritize, through external funding mechanisms, the financial support for collective production and publication of researchers linked to the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, with a preference for texts written in English.
- Art. 6. In cases of invitations from the receiving university, to impulse university mobility, the PPCJ/UNIVALI will prioritize the allocation of funding to the refereed activity, detailing the activities to be developed, being mandatory the collective scientific production and publication from the researchers linked to the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, ensuring an equitable distribution of prospective visiting periods abroad and values among the PPCJ/UNIVALI researchers.
- Art. 7. The results of teaching, research, innovation, and extension activities following from the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University must expressly mention the academic affiliation of the researchers with the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University; the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University; the respective Areas of Concentration, Research Lines, and Research Projects; and the existence or absence of funding.



- **Art. 8.** The researchers affiliated with the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University, upon receipt of funding, must, in thirty (30) days after the conclusion of the activities, submit an Accountability Statement to the PPCJ/UNIVALI Secretariat, describing the joint activities results, as well as its adherence to the respective Areas of Concentration, Research Lines, and Research Projects.
- **Art. 9.** The researchers affiliated with the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University must immediately report all activities carried out into their respective *Currículo Lattes/CNPq*.
- **Art. 10.** Researchers affiliated with the Joint International Research Program for Scientific and Technical Production between the PPCJ/UNIVALI and the Delaware Law School/Widener University must prioritize joint research proposals and funding for calls and invitations, observing the possibility of expanding international research networks.
- **Art. 11.** Until the issuance of specific subsequent regulations, Joint International Research Programs for Scientific and Technical Production between PPCJ/UNIVALI and the *Università degli Studi di Perugia* (Italy), the *Universidad de Alicante* (Spain), and the *Universidad de Caldas* (Colombia) will be governed, by analogy, by this Regulatory Instruction.
- **Art. 12.** This Regulatory Instruction and its respective translation into the English language shall come into force on the date of their signatures, revoking any contrary provisions.
